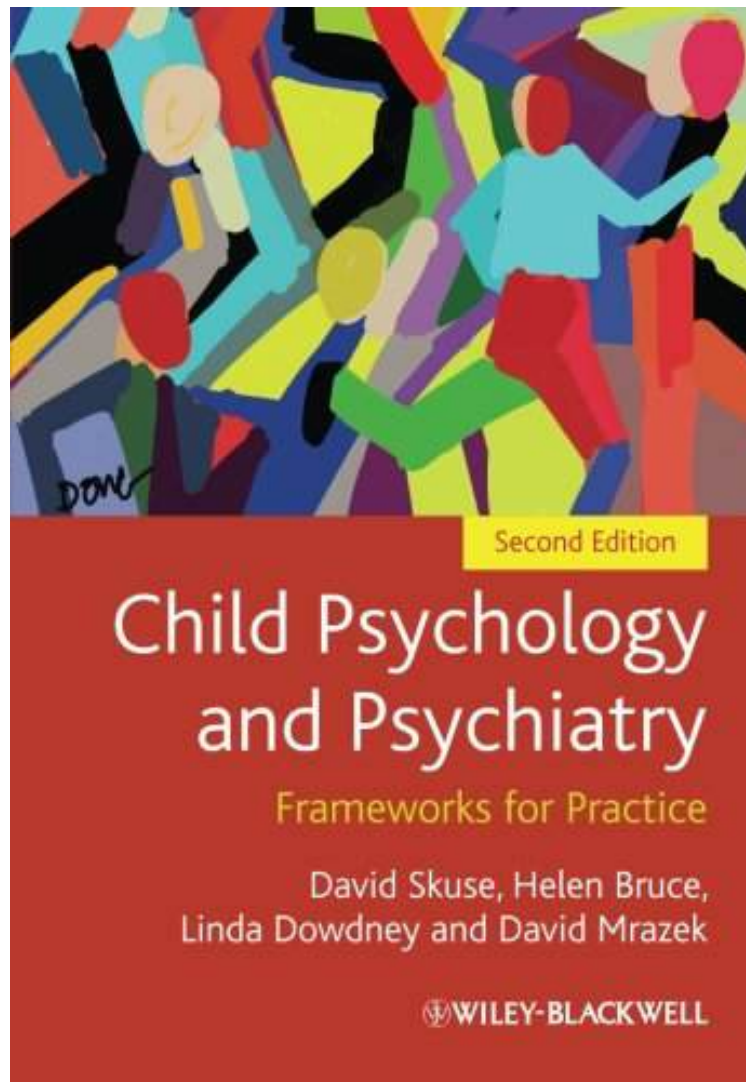


Child Psychology and Psychiatry: Frameworks for Practice
