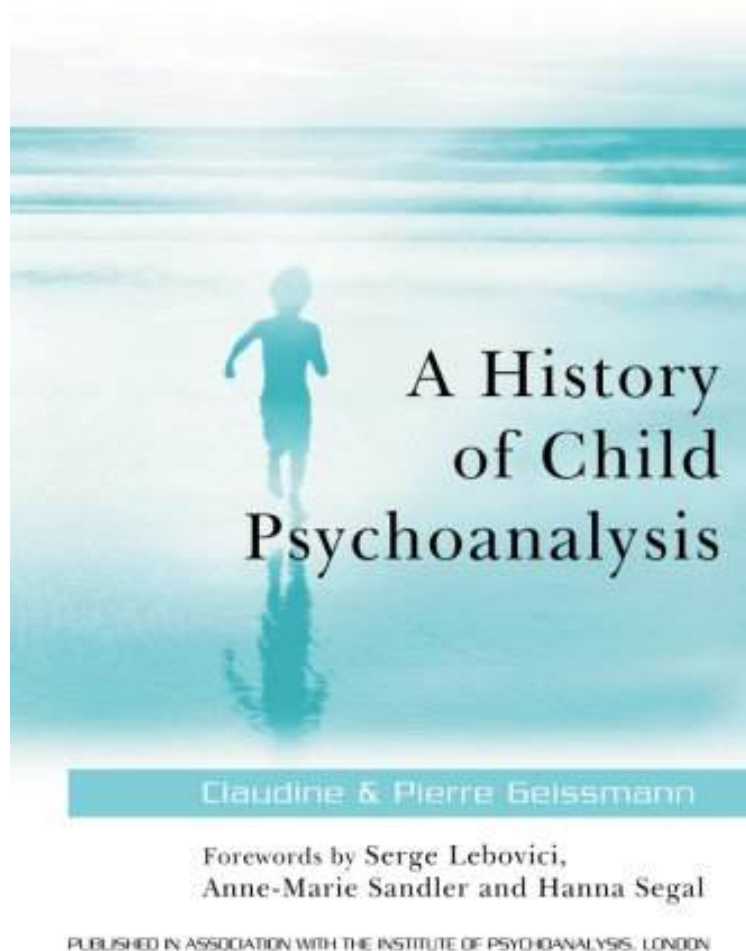


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## A History of Child Psychoanalysis (The New Library of Psychoanalysis)

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Child analysis has occupied a special place in the history of psychoanalysis because of the challenges it poses to practitioners and the clashes it has provoked among its advocates Since the early days in Vienna under Sigmund Freud child psychoanalysts have tried to comprehend and make comprehensible to others the psychosomatic troubles of childhood and to adapt clinical and therapeutic approaches to all the stages of development of the baby the child the adolescent The arguments are carefully documented with an exhaustive bibliography and with quotations and interviews with a number of psych analysts This is a fascinating account from which the reader will have to draw his own conclusion Journa
